Thanks to an innovative vacuumed rotary belt (patented) there is no need of adhesive for transportation of the paper avoiding a huge use of chemical adhesives.

While the Company is clearly focused towards reinforcing current markets and opening new ones, Aleph is strongly committed in assuring that current customers are fully satisfied with the expected features with LAFORTE®. In addition to the textile industry Aleph will target the laminated paper sector for the production of laminated floorings and panels for
